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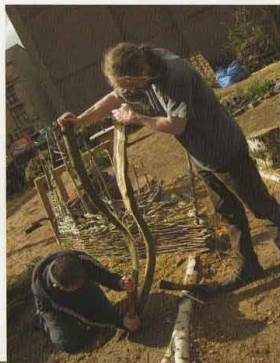

Projects for all

We run a number of practical workshops which are an exciting and informative way to engage children and adults, raising their awareness of environmental and sustainability issues while having fun and being creative!

Examples include:

Outdoor classrooms, den and shelter building, storytelling chairs, benches, totem poles herb beds, compost bins and recycled/reclaimed wood fencing

Spoon making, bows and arrows, wilderness skills, green woodworking, pole-lathe turning and wood carving workshops

Herbal medicine workshops

These workshops cater for all ages. The level of involvement of the group will depend on the age of the participants and it's size. For school projects we aim to get the children involved in helping to make the structures at a level appropriate to them.

We aim to facilitate the therapeutic aspects of traditional crafts, fostering the connection between children, adults and nature.

Our activities support concentration, confidence and team building.
